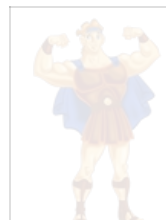

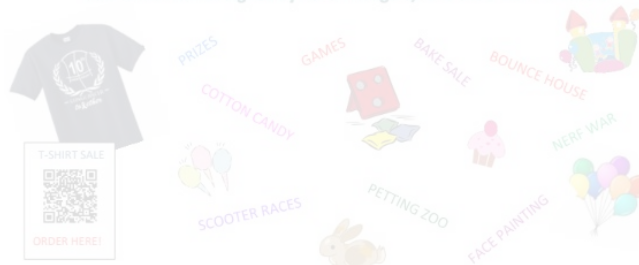

New Visitor Procedure

In order to ensure the safety of our students and staff, the District will now be utilizing the Raptor security software in all

of our schools. **Visitors and/or volunteers must present their drivers license or a photo id upon arrival in the office.** It will be scanned by office personnel, and a badge printed with your picture along with the date and time. This badge must be visible while you are in the building during the school day. If you are dropping something off in the office, or signing your child in or out of school, you will not need to present your id. A new badge will be created each time you visit, so it is important to always have your photo id with you.

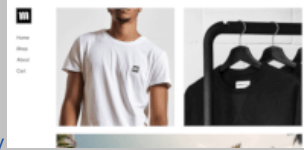
