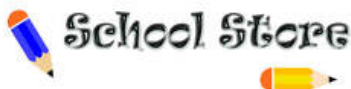

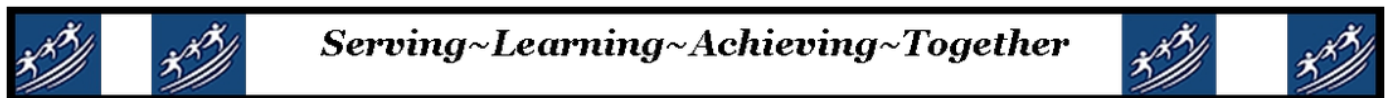
### **Profile of a Graduate: Communication**

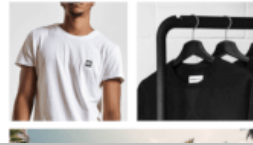
