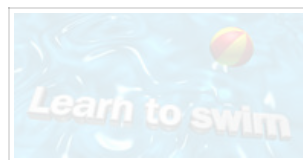


2019 FIELD DAY - MAY 31ST!

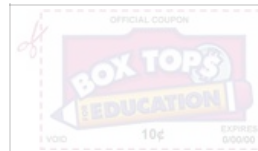

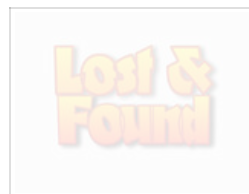

- Can allow others to lead

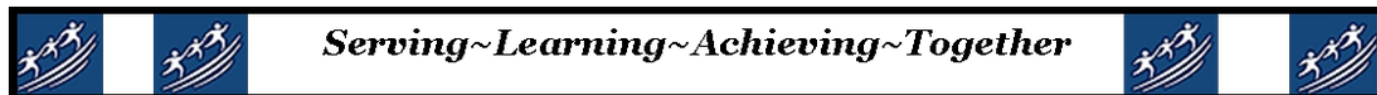

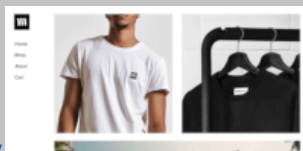
