- Library Mural Project

- 2019-20 School Theme-Suamico Transforms (tied to the district theme of "Transforming Together")
 - Next our library space will be transformed from a 20th century learning space to a 21st century space.
 - Last year our theme was "Together is better." This year the 2019-2020 is Suamico Transforms, "Making Changes for the Better" These changes could be big or small. Suamico Elementary is using a butterfly to show transformation. Changes takes hard work, grit, perseverance. Students were given the message to start out by being awesome, your mindset matters.
 - Ryan showed a Kid President video about "How to Change the World"
 - This concept is also supported everyday on the announcements.
